Brief of the Event:

The event started with registration at 8.30am and followed with opening speech by Area Commander, Dr Lee Toong Chow. He then continued with the 1st topic to introduce SJAM and its services, contributions and activities to all participants and PPD officer. After the brief introduction, the 2nd topic was about all the important information and knowledge of SJAM. After the morning break, the participants were separated into 2 groups, ie. Group 1 (Adults & Cadets) for Secondary School Teacher Advisors was in charged by ASO Cadet, Mr Leong and Group 2 (Juniors) for Primary School Teacher Advisors was in charged by ASO (Juniors) Mdm. Elsie Ooi. In this workshop, participants were shared with topics on how to plan their weekly activities with available SJAM Trainings subjects. All teacher advisors encouraged to plan the weekly activities with more fun programme and towards better achievement for their members, e.g. Grand Prior Badge Awards (for cadets) and Junior Star Awards (for juniors).

All participants were gathered back to the Auditorium after lunch. A short video clips about SJAM Penang emergency service were shown to all participants. It was then continued the afternoon session where Dr. Lee shared on the topic of Division Organisation and Honorary rank that is applicable to officers in Education Department, school principle and teachers. SEVENTEEN-YEAR-OLD Quintus U-Wei Baptist has wanted to become a doctor ever since he was a kid.

That led him to St John Ambulance Malaysia (SJAM) at SMK Bukit Jambul, knowing that it would allow him to amass a wealth of experience in making crucial life-saving decisions.

Five years down the road, the aspiring doctor is now a recipient of the 'One Star and One Stripe Award', a Cadet Service Award that recognises those who have successfully achieved the efficiency requirement and are active in their service.

"Since I was a child, I have always wanted to help people who are sick.

"It is an ideal training ground for me to work towards achieving my dream," he said at the SJAM northeast area 11th Cadet Day at the SJAM headquarters in Grove Road, Penang, recently.

He was one of the two award recipients for the category. The other recipient was his schoolmate H'ng Wei Dan, 17, who also wanted to become a doctor and planned to apply for medical colleges after finishing secondary school.

SJAM Penang northeast area commander Dr Lee Toong Chow said there were several requirements to qualify for the award.

"It is based on efficiency in administering first aid, the attendance, as well as a minimum number of hours put in to serve the community," he said.

The award ceremony was held together with the SJAM Cadets Enrolment ceremony which saw a total of 180 new cadets from nine schools taking their oath.

Dr Lee said the annual SJAM Cadet Day was organised to officially enrol new cadets and mark the beginning of their journey in acquiring life-saving knowledge and skills, leadership and management experiences.

"Young people aged between 12 and 18 constitute almost 75% of SJAM membership.

"They would learn Cadet Proficiency subjects outside their school curricular to achieve the Grand Prior's Badge, the highest international award which a cadet can achieve during their cadet years.

"It is the aim of every cadet to be the Grand Prior Cadet," he said.

（ 檳城 24 日讯 ） 檳州东北区圣约翰救伤机构欢庆第 11 届圣约翰少年日之际，来自各校的 180 名新少年团队员一起宣誓，其中 2 名荣获少年服务勋章的队员，积极朝向医生目标前进，未来以更好的服务回馈大众。

槟州副总指挥官兼东北区指挥官李栋超周日致词时指出，圣约翰救伤机构少年日乃是年度庆典之一，当天带来新队员们宣誓成为少年队员，开始他们的急救、护理、管理及领导的学习之路。

"今天共有 180 名新队员们参与宣誓活动，包括槟州 9 间中学，另有 3 间中学因与校方活动撞期而没有出席。"

他说，"勋章徽章"是每位队员们的学习目标，是一个里程碑，而他们今日也颁出少年组特别服务勋章予 50 名队员和少年组服务勋章予 21 名队员，其中在少年服务勋章里，有 2 名来自武吉占姆国中的队员，荣获 1 星 1 条纹的勋章，他们自小的愿望都是成为一名称职的医生，在未来治疗和服务大众。

他说，这个1星1条纹勋章得来不易，获1条纹勋章的条件是必须参与满一年，而1星条纹则是满3年，期间必须参与至少11次重要会议和服务超过30小时等。

The whole program ended around 5pm at Esplanade.



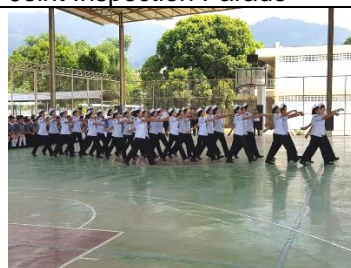

Cadet handbook are getting good responses, comments and encouragement from other States Officers too. It's still open for sales to all members who are interested.

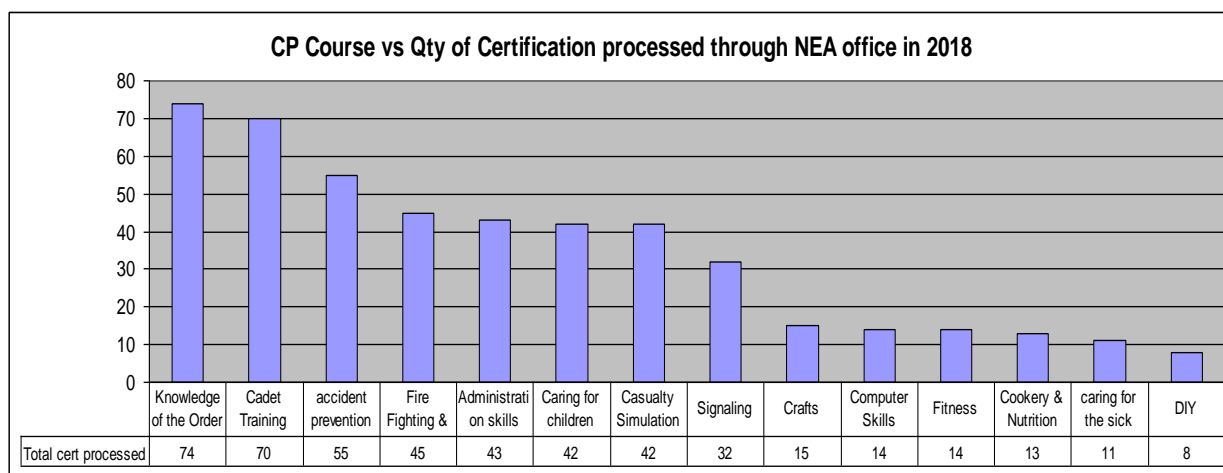
CADET PROFICIENCY TRAINING SCHEME

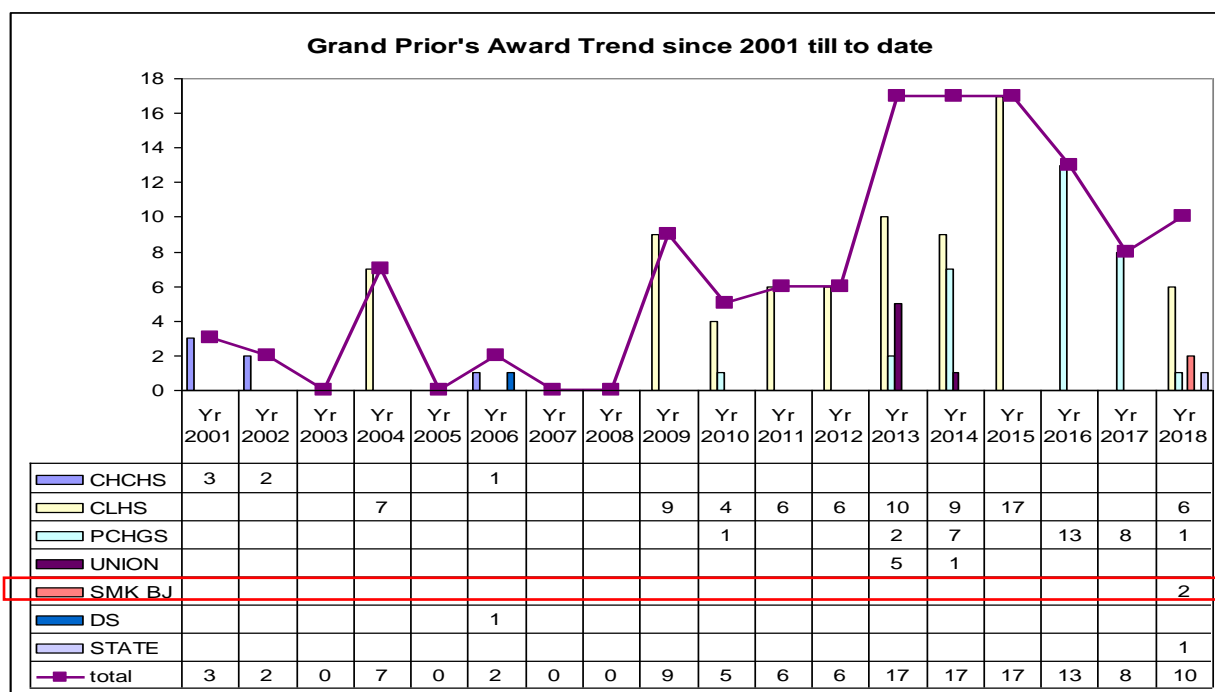

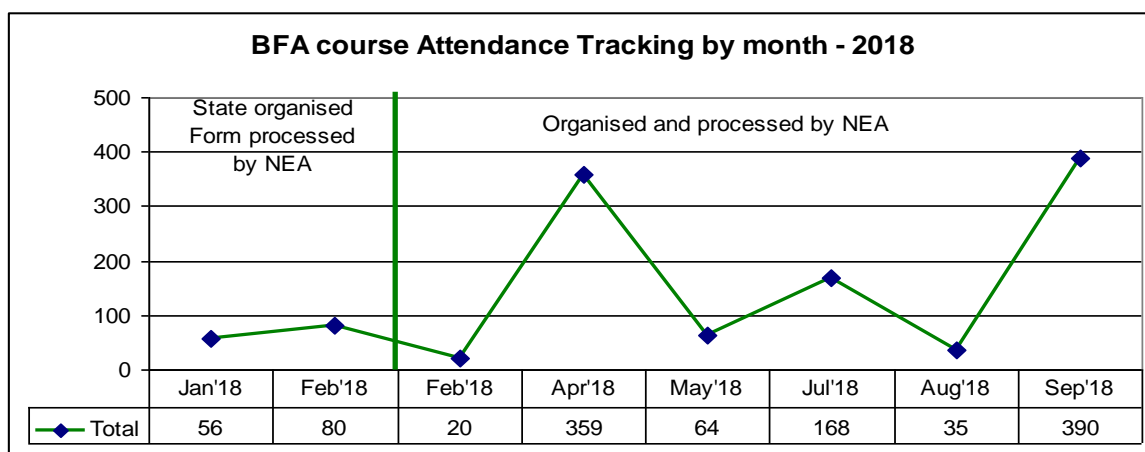

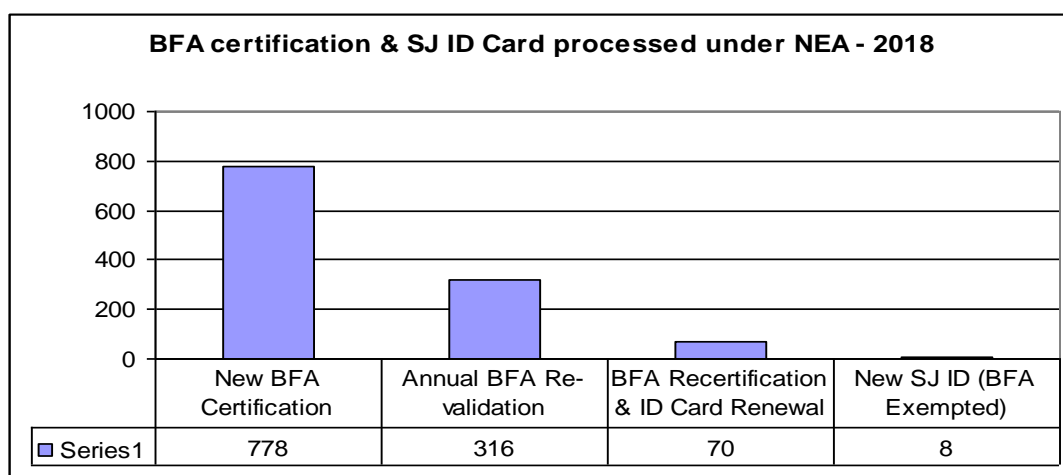

BASIC FIRST AID

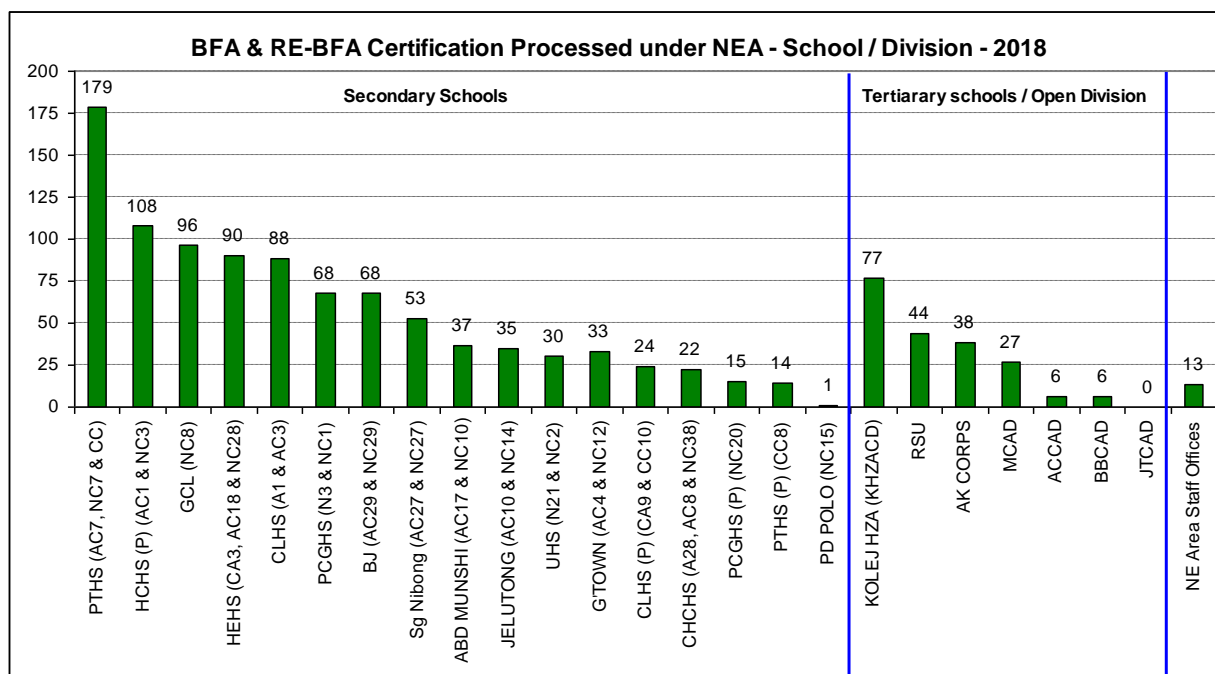

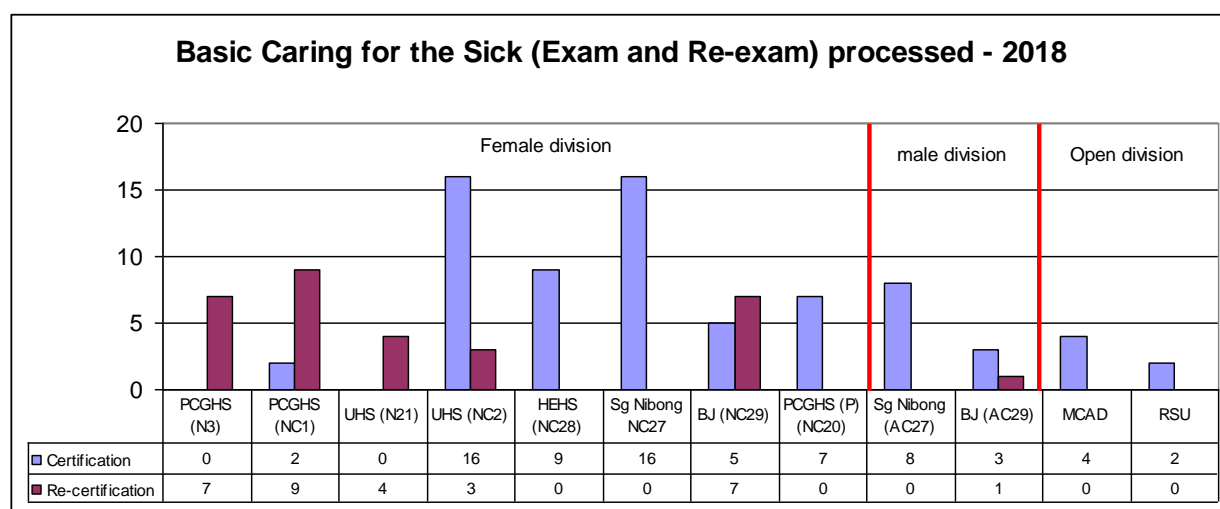
This chart indicates the BFA certification processed breakdown according to school / division.

'I owe the boys my life'

Back-from-the-dead man to meet his teen saviours soon

GEORGE TOWN: A man who was clinically dead for 12 minutes will soon meet his heroes – five teenage boys.

Long Soo Keat will meet them when more than 1,000 people gather to learn the skills that the boys used to save him – cardio pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) – and how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED).

"I can't wait to meet the boys. I haven't even spoken to them. I owe them my life," said the 49-year-old real estate agent.

On Sept 1, Long had a sudden cardiac arrest during a football match with his fellow Chung Ling High School alumni at the school field.

The five boys – St John Ambulance Malaysia (SJAM) L/Cpl Gabriel Soon Chai Long, 16, Pvt Liong Jun Yong, 16, 14-year-old cadets Ansley Tan Zhong, S, Shaman and Tang Yi Ze – were on duty and used CPR and the school's AED to get Long's heart to beat again after 12 minutes.

Long was warned for nearly two weeks and discharged only last Friday.

SJAM state staff officer Dr Lawrence Tan explained that Long's sudden cardiac arrest was not the same as a heart attack.

"A heart attack is when blood supply to your heart is blocked. Many have heart attacks and survive.

"Sudden cardiac arrest is a malfunction in your heart and it stops beating. You lose consciousness

without warning and the survival rate in Malaysia from that hovers at only 1%," he said.

Long will meet his rescuers on Oct 9 at the MASS CPR-AED 2018 in Pesta Site, Sungai Nibong, which will see over 1,000 people learning the skill.

Penang Heart Safe Programme chairman Datuk Dr Luah Lean Wah said although most of the participants are policemen, firemen, servicemen and personnel from the Malaysian Civil Defence, there are still slots available for the public.

"If you know CPR, you can save

someone from sudden cardiac arrest because there are 40 public AEDs you can use," she said.

The state's public AEDs, made by Zoll Medical Corporation (ZOLL), gives real-time feedback with voice commands to tell rescuers what to do.

State Health Committee chairman Dr Afif Bahardin confirmed that Long's rescue was the first time a public AED was used to save a life here.

"Each AED costs more than RM8,000. ZOLL, the state and other donors invested over RM320,000

on the 40 AEDs.

"To be able to save just this one life makes it worth it for all of us," Dr Afif said.

Initiated in 2015, ZOLL first donated five AEDs to Penang and today, the state government and other organisations have installed 40 public AEDs in schools, parks, business and government premises.

Their locations are shown on the SJAM HeartSafe Penang's Facebook page.

Five teens and AED save footballer's life

GEORGE TOWN: For 12 minutes, a footballer stood at death's gates when his heart stopped.

And the ones who brought him back were five steady-minded teenagers armed with an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

Recalling the incident, St John Ambulance Malaysia (SJAM) cadet Anshley Tan Zhong, 14, said he saw real-estate agent Long Soo Keat pass out during a football match with his fellow Chung Ling alumni.

Tan rushed to him and called out to his team members to join him.

Their senior, SJAM L/Cpl Gabriel Soon Chai Long, 16, quickly realised Long, 49, was about to die.

"His pulse was irregular and then stopped. He was gasping heavily. We call that agonal breathing, the sign of a heart attack," he said.

What followed on Sept 1 saw the teenagers bringing Long back from the brink by using the public AED in Chung Ling High School, Ayer Itam.

The Star met Soon, Tan, SJAM Pvt Liong Jun Yong, 16, and cadets S. Shaman and Tang Yi Ze, both 14, after their debriefing session at SJAM's headquarters on Saturday.

Recounting the incident, Tan said he told a bystander to run to the AED kiosk on the school grounds, break the glass to unlock the device and bring it to them.

Soon then took out the AED sensor

pads and attached them to Long's chest. The AED analysed Long's condition and its voice-prompt told Soon to perform cardiac pulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

Though Soon had practised hundreds of times, it was the first time he did CPR for real.

"The latest CPR research recommends 30 chest compressions and then two rescue breaths per cycle.

"The AED's voice-prompt kept telling me to 'push harder'. The victim was bigger than me and I used all my strength," Soon said.

At intervals, the AED told Soon to

stop touching Long so that it could deliver electric shocks of 150 to 200 volts.

"The device gave him three shocks and when the ambulance came, he was given another shock with the ambulance's defibrillator.

"Only after that did his heart beat again," he said.

Soon said the AED's analysis showed the CPR he did weakened as the seconds went by.

"We must take turns doing CPR because it is tiring. But I was so focused on saving his life that I didn't remember. I will never forget now," he said.

Long was warded for nearly two weeks. He was discharged on Friday and is now recuperating at home.

"The five boys are heroes. I think other people would have panicked but the boys were well-trained.

"When I blacked out, I felt no pain ... I was just suddenly gone. I played football nearly every week. My stamina is not good and I tire quickly. I have high blood pressure.

"But I never knew my heart was in danger. I want everyone around my age to go for a check-up, even if you think nothing is wrong," Long told *The Star*.

Penang Heart Safe Programme chairman Datuk Dr Luah Lean Wah said the state's public AEDs, made by Zoll Medical Corporation (ZOLL), gave real-time feedback with voice commands to give instructions to rescuers on what to do.
