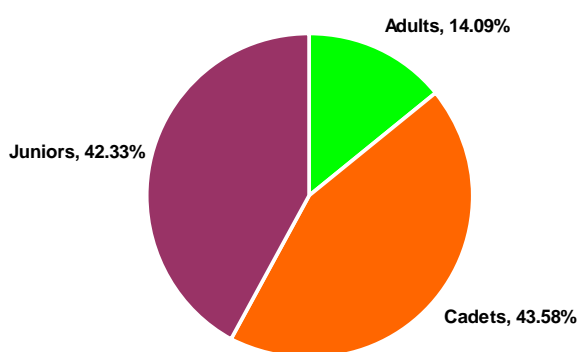

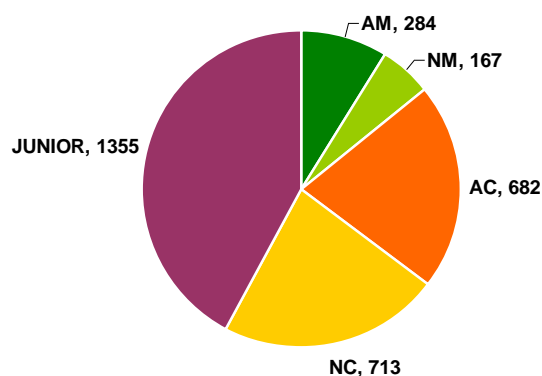
DIVISION MEMBERSHIP STRENGTH IN NORTH EAST AREA

SUMMARY OF OVERALL MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY BY %



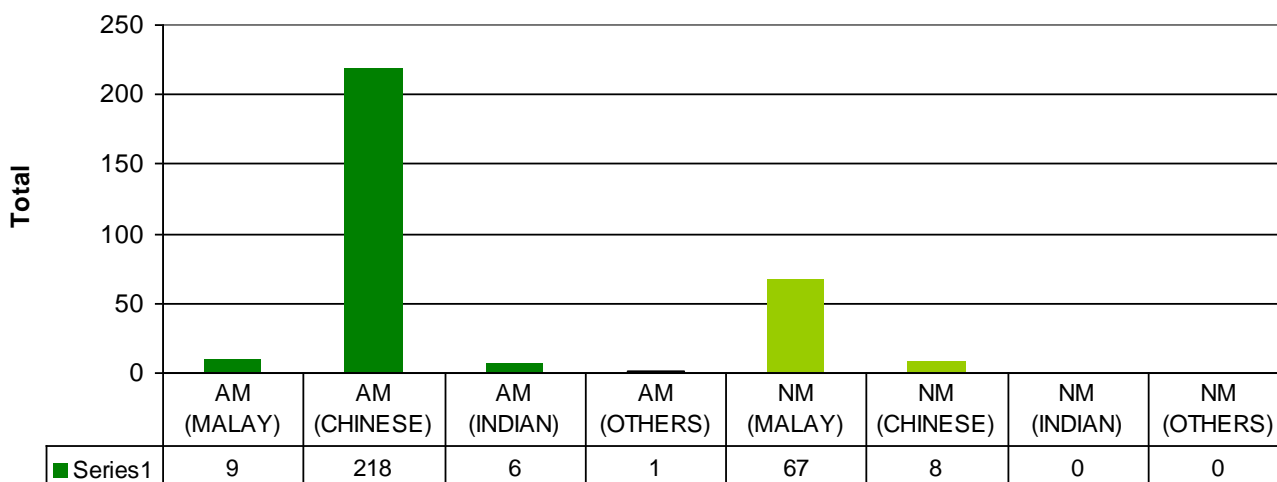
SUMMARY OF OVERALL MEMBERSHIP UNDER NEA YR2019

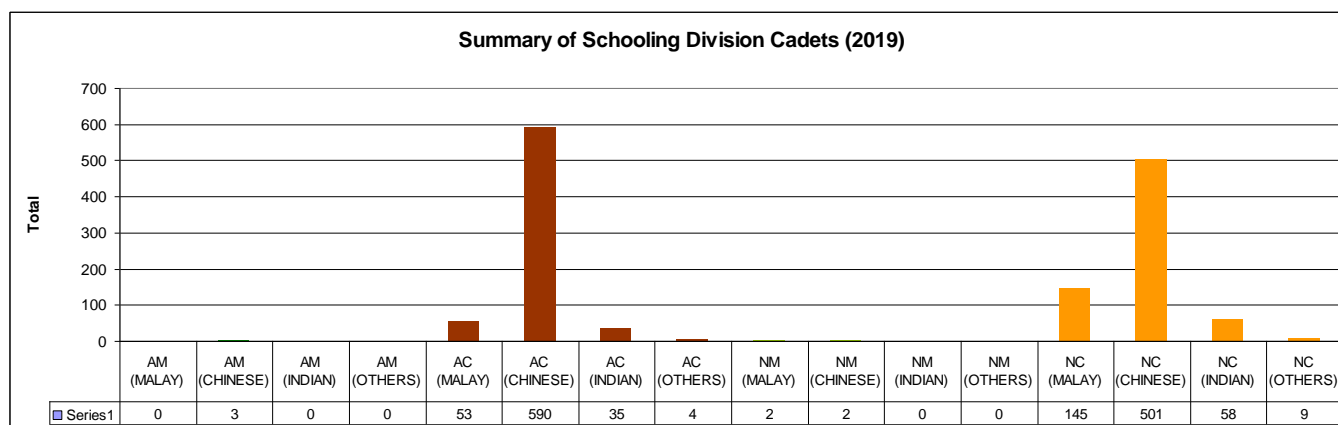
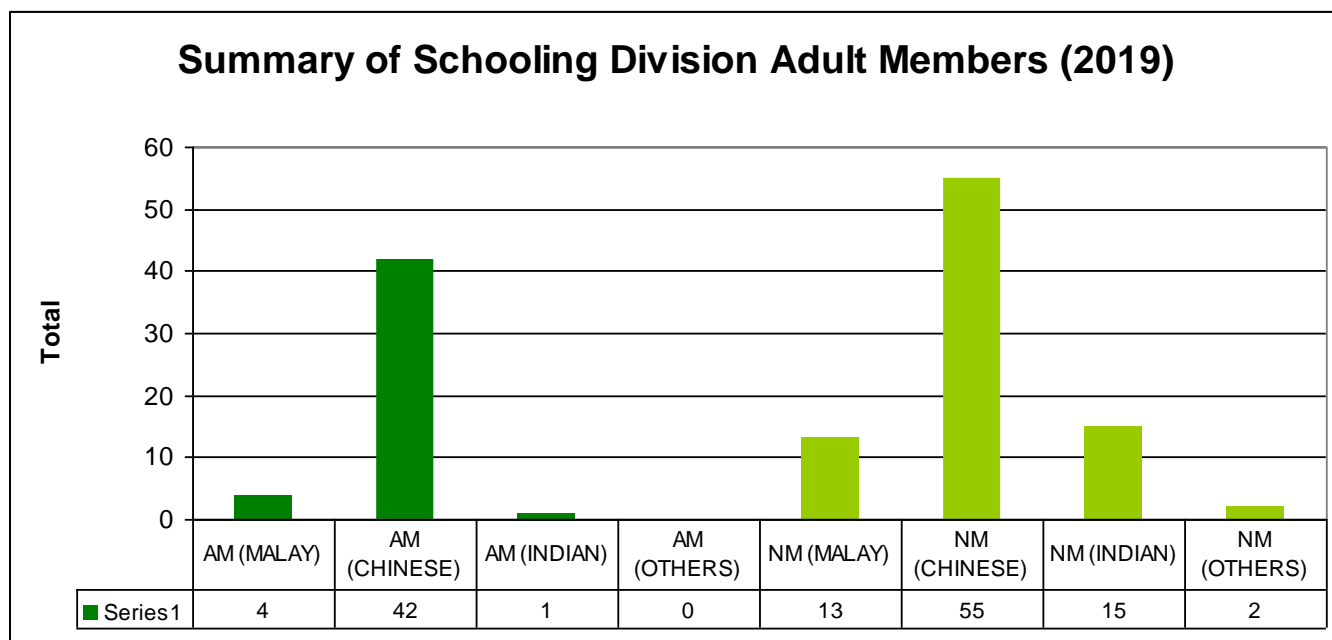

Brief of the Event:

The event started of with an opening by Area Commander, Dr Lee TC followed the speech by Pegawai PPD. Both of them share about the basic introduction of both organisation SJAM and PPD and how its function. The program then continued with Basic First Aid course which all the topics have been shared SJAM Trainers and been examined as accordance to the training policy.

The final part of the event is continued with workshops where teachers learned more in depth on their respective cadet and junior areas, shared example on how to plain their school activities with incorporating the Cadet Proficiency Trainings Scheme and St. John Junior Training Scheme, other than the usual core training subject (First aid, Caring for the Sick & Foot Drills). These shared examples comes with an intention which is to guide school Cadets' and Juniors' to learn more useful knowledge, skills and to drive them towards achieving the Grand Prior Badge Awards (for cadets) and St. John Junior Star Awards (for juniors). **SJAM Induction and SJ Training materials were shared to all Teacher Advisors** so they can teach their cadets and juniors when going back to schools

Before the end of the workshop session, an open dialog session has been conducted between SJAM, PPD and teacher advisors. The aim of this dialog session was to provide opportunity for all to seek clarification and advice from SJAM or PPD levels where the representatives were Cik Noor Fatirah (PPD) and officers from NEA Office.

As this year event is incorporated with Basic First Aid class with the aim to train and certified more SJAM teacher advisor with Basic First Aid. There were **total of 39 TEACHERS attended and been trained** in this workshop. As compared to previous year 2018, total of 30 Teacher Advisors attended. 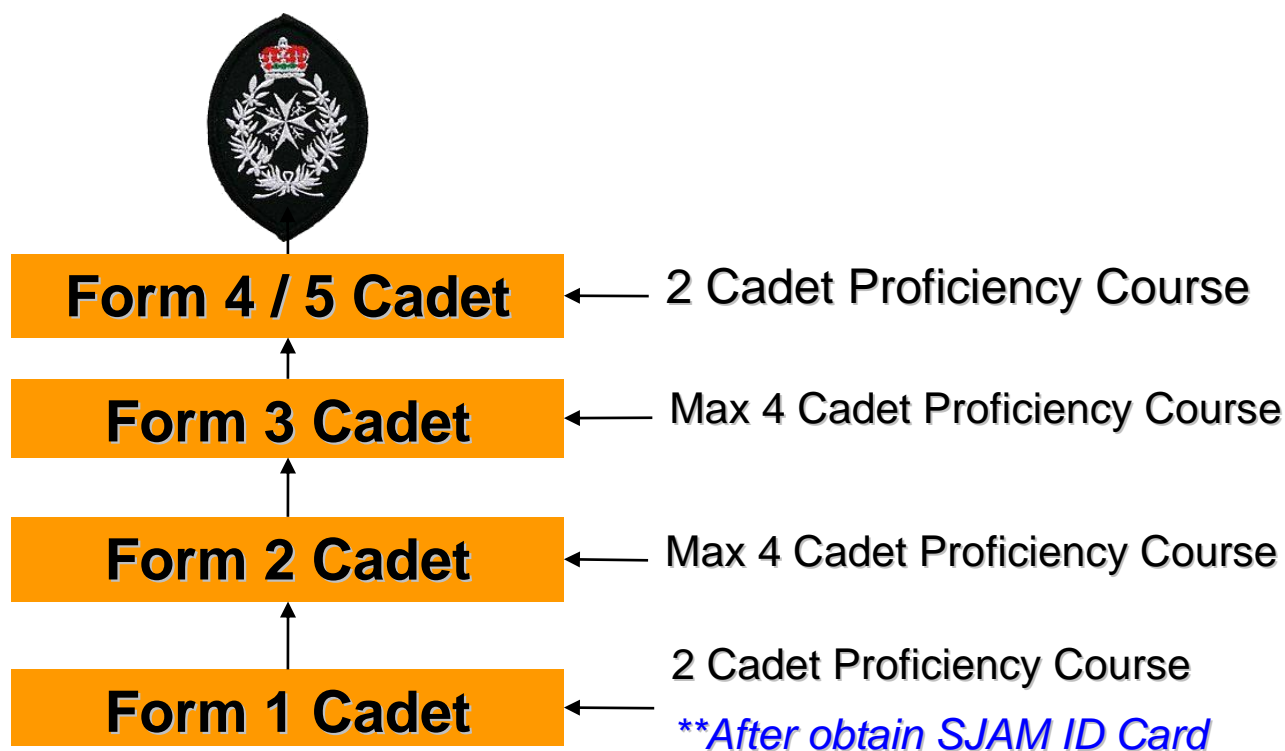

Cadet Proficiency Training Scheme

Cadet Proficiency Training Scheme is another sub-curricular training scheme which allows cadets to actively involve and to gain additional co-curricular knowledge and skills which are different from the usual learning subjects (First Aid, Caring for the Sick and Foot Drill). These training schemes also provide opportunity for cadets to pursue towards the highest international awards ***“The Grand Prior’s Badge Awards”***.

CADET PROFICIENCY TRAINING DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

Since year 2018, NEA has taken the initiative to revamp the current Cadet Proficiency Training Scheme and bring it into next level with more structured and organised training scheme arranged. The structured approach (***named as 2:4:4:2 Cadet Proficiency Training Plan***) which shared to the school leaders and teacher advisors during the SJAM Induction was to guide them on how to plan and organize the Cadet Proficiency Course Subjects for their fellow young cadets as accordance to their joining years. This will helps the cadet to learn each of the relevant subjects starting from basic to move forward to more challenging skills as when they grow up during their cadet years.

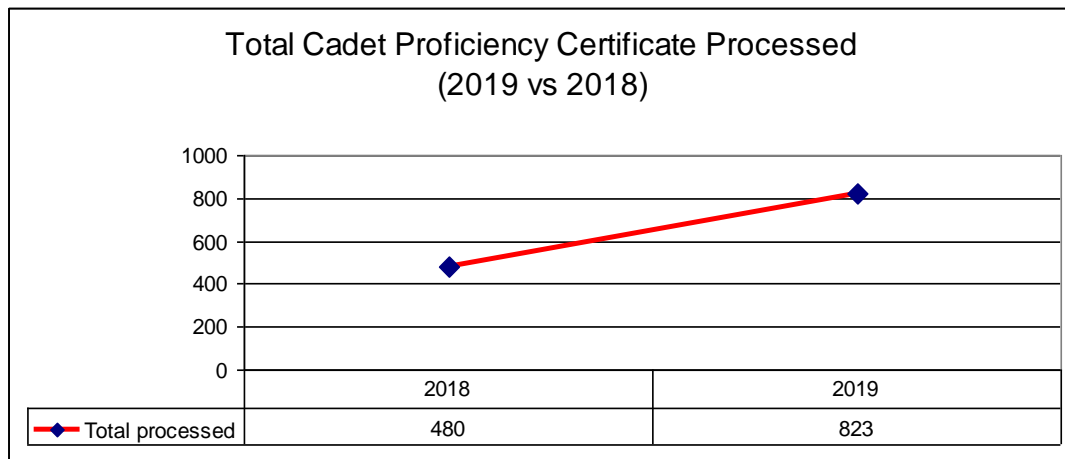

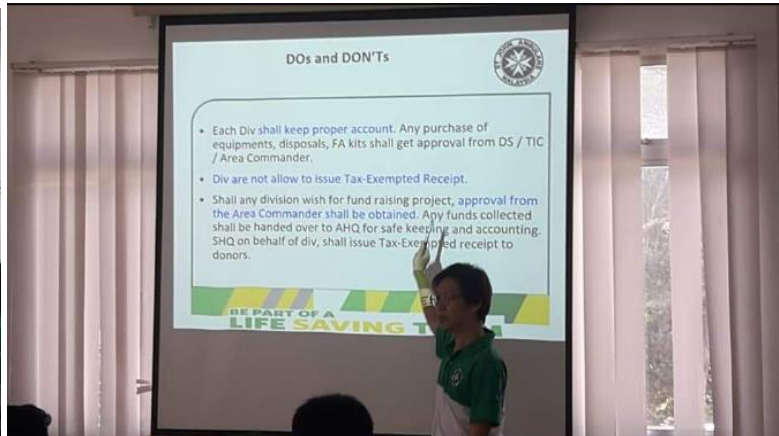

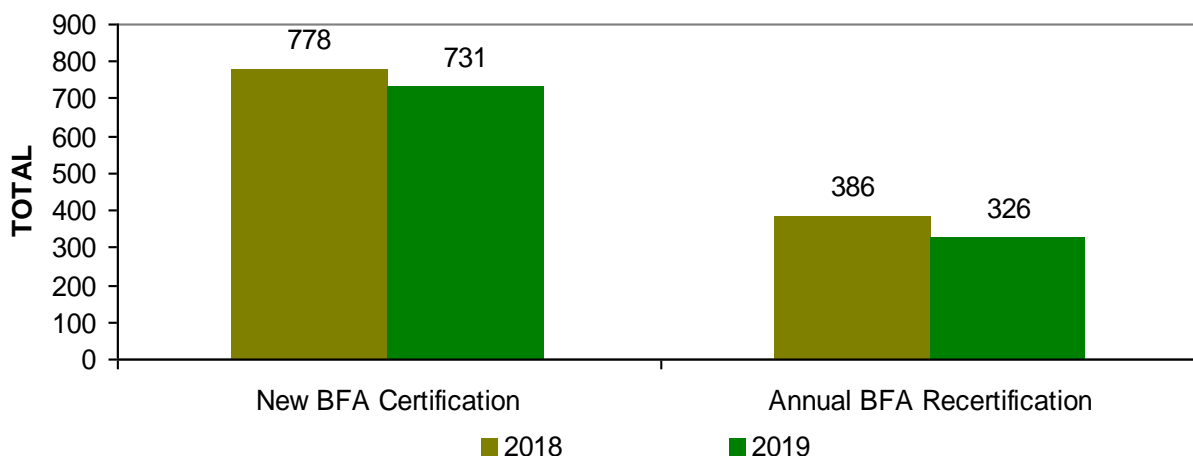
TRAINING & EXAMINATION

Basic First Aid Course

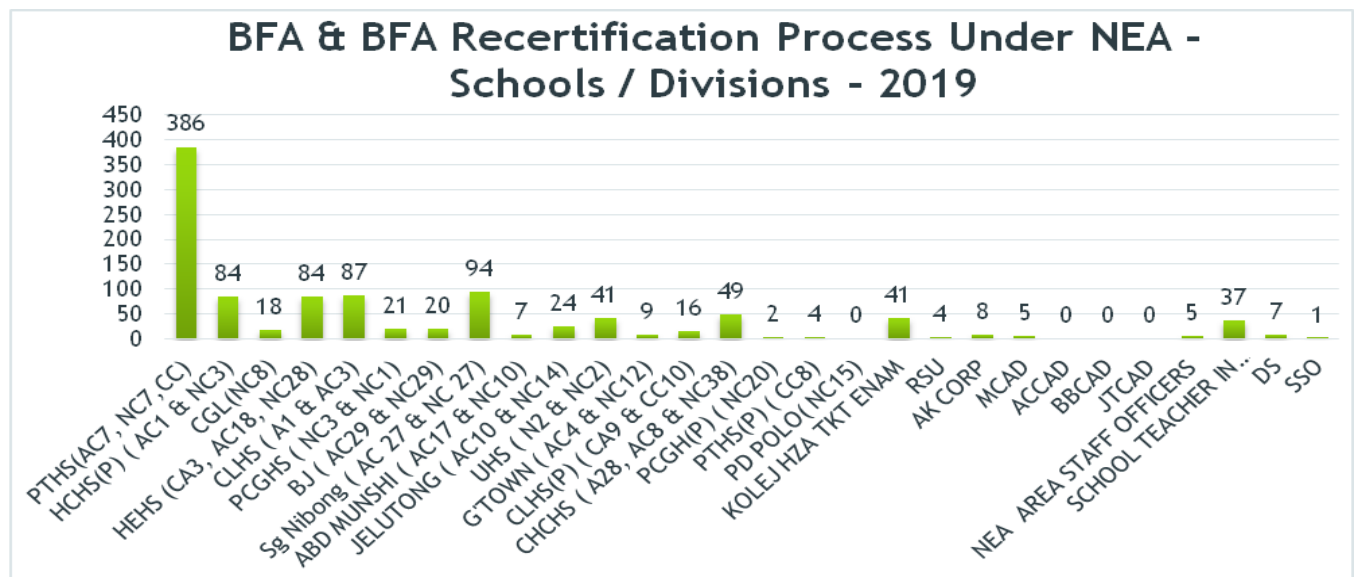
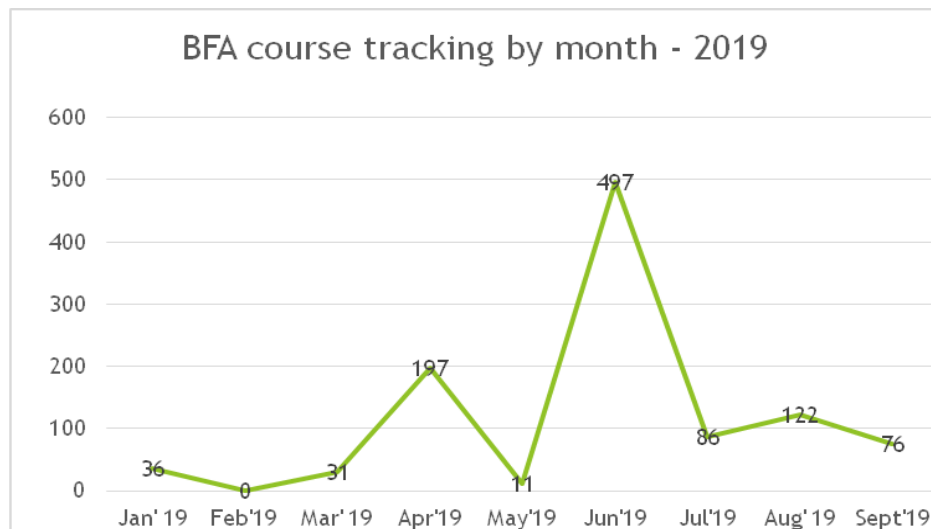
NEA Office has scheduled Basic First Aid (BFA) course and examination for members and cadets under NEA throughout whole 2019. In this year, **total of 1057** combination of officers, members and cadets took part in the BFA examination either for new membership registration or to fulfill their annual efficiency requirement.

The chart below shows the BFA certifications which have been processed for year 2018 & 2019. In Year 2019, there are total of **731 new cadets passes for their BFA certifications** and obtained new registered SJAM ID.

Training the Trainer

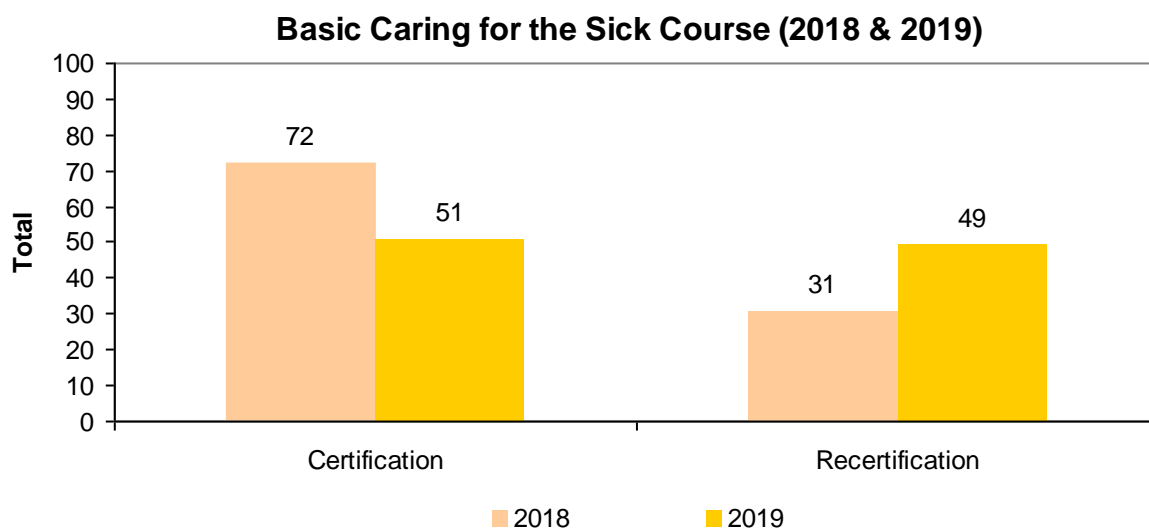

This course not only cater for the compulsory needs from Nursing Member/Cadets, but is also open the door for Ambulance Cadets to take part as part of their challenge in Cadet Proficiency Course (Caring for the Sick).

From the records shows that total of **51 new certifications** and **49 re-certification of BCS** has been **processed in year 2019**. That makes up a total of 100 participants took part in the course and passes the examination assessment.

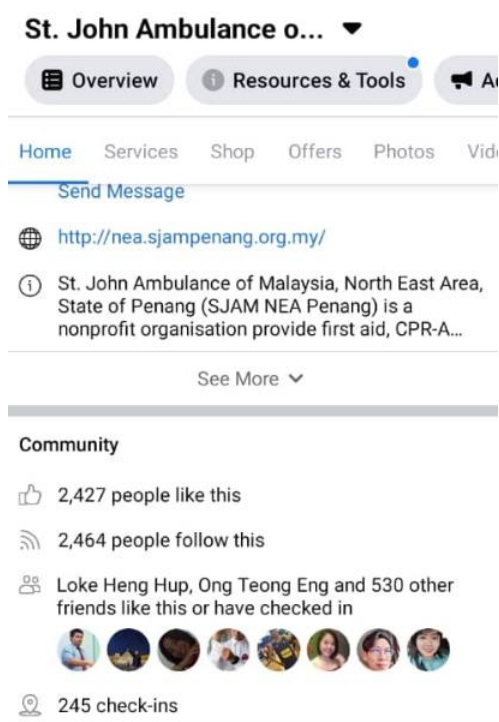
